Link Union Station Project

COMBINED FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT / RECORD OF DECISION

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) and the California High-Speed Rail Authority (CHSRA) announce the availability of the *Link Union Station (Link US) Project Combined Final Environmental Impact Statement/Record of Decision (Combined Final EIS/ROD)*, which has been prepared and made available pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

Metro is the Project sponsor, joint NEPA lead agency, and lead agency for state environmental reviews under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by NEPA and most applicable federal environmental laws for the Project are being or have been carried out by the State of California pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) dated July 23, 2019 (renewed July 22, 2024), and executed by the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) and the State of California. Under that MOU, CHSRA is the Project's lead agency under NEPA.

The Link US Combined Final EIS/ROD will be available to the public on March 13, 2026 in PDF format on Metro's website (www.linkunionstation.com). Metro's website also contains the previously released Draft EIS/Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) (published June 21, 2024) and information on previous approvals, including the Link US Final SEIR (approved in October 2025 by Metro Board of Directors).




Figure 1. Project Location and Regional Vicinity
